VAUJANY HAS IT ALL!

WITH A POPULATION OF 350 AND A CAPACITY FOR 3 500 TOURIST BEDS, THE ART OF MOUNTAIN LIVING IS INTACT, IMBUED WITH AUTHENTICITY, TO OFFER VACATIONS FULL OF ENCOUNTERS AND GOOD TIMES SHARED.

Without fanfare or trumpets, Vaujany has made its history quietly and discreetly, clinging to the flanks of the great Oisans massifs: Grandes Rousses, Taillefer and Belledonne. Vaujany is a village, now a resort, that has preserved its soul and traditions, while at the same time keeping up with the times and deploying a treasure trove of leisure and sports facilities, at envy of many. The virtuous turn taken 35 years ago thanks to hydroelectricity and the construction of the Grand Maison dam, one of the largest in Europe, propelled Vaujany towards its destiny as a tourist resort in 1989.

Vaujany's traditional Alpine architecture has preserved the village's age-old appearance. It features chalets, hotels and small residences that respect the architectural codes of mountain living. As for the ski area, the paradox is obvious: Vaujany's confidential, intimate atmosphere contrasts with the formidable horizons it offers on the slopes. Its ski area is linked to the Grand Domaine de l'Alpe d'Huez, whose highest point is the Pic Blanc at 3 330 m with a playground of 250 km of runs and 53 of which are part of the Oz-Vaujany ski area...

Located 50 mn from Grenoble by car, this little corner of paradise proudly boasts state-of-the-art facilities for comfortable stays: sports complex, swimming pool, skating rink, cinema, museum, mediatheque, spas, gondola, covered escalators for easy access to the different levels of the resort for a 100% pedestrian stay.



VAUJANY UNE HISTORY AND A FUTURE

Small yet immense, Vaujany is a thousand-year-old mountain village that has embraced modernity while guarding its soul.

Human presence in Vaujany can be traced back to **the Bronze Age**, with the first traces of copper mining in the foothills of the Grandes Rousses massif.

The village's main activity has always been agriculture and pastoralism. In winter, the men were peddlers, specializing in haberdashery and set off to trade in faraway lands, leaving their wives and children in the village.

From the 50s to the 80s, life in the mountains was difficult and restrictive, and families left to seek a better future in town. The turning point in Vaujaniate history came in 1986 with the construction of the Grand Maison hydroelectric dam, the most powerful hydroelectric facility in France. In its wake, the Vaujany ski resort was created in 1989. Since then, the resort has grown steadily, while retaining its village feel. In 1999, the resort was revitalized with the creation of the Pôle Sports et Loisirs, including a swimming pool, gymnasium, fitness room and wellness area. In 2012, the village continued its development with the creation of an indoor skating rink, bowling alley and children's center.



Vaujany now has all the facilities a village could dream of, and puts them at the disposal of its visitors to offer them.

ÉCO-RESPONSABILITY 5 SUSTAINABLE COMMITMENTS

Vaujany, a resort committed to sustainable development, which goes hand in hand with the rational development of the resort, which aims to remain on a human scale.

STATION VERTE, A HIGHLY PRIZED LABEL

Mindful of the remarkable environment offered by the mountains, the commune of Vaujany sought recognition for its efforts and was awarded the Station Verte Label in 2014. This label defines a welcoming territory in the heart of the terroirs, recognized at national level as an organized resort, offering stays in favor of natural, authentic, human and environmentally-friendly tourism... As part of this approach, all the village department have also been committed for years to implement environmentally-friendly actions to control its environmental impact in the fields of communication, purchasing, sorting, events, publications, travel management...

architects were keen not to lose the precious energy generated by the two generators that produce the ice. The energy recovered from these units is then redistributed to the various areas requiring heating, namely the swimming pool, the ice rink and the children's centre. The aim was to keep boiler operation to a minimum, and thus the use of fuel oil.

► Thermal renovation of municipal buildings

The commune of Vaujany, with the support of the Isère department and the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region, has undertaken a thermal renovation campaign to make its communal buildings more environmentally-friendly.

▶ To go further, make a daily commitment!

Vaujany is mobilizing local players around the creation of an action charter to steadily reduce its energy and its waste consumption by 2025. The result of this coconstruction will be a guideline that will bring together the small and large actions that the community needs to take to support the village's eco-responsibility, and that everyone will be able to draw inspiration from to become an eco-responsible player.

ENCOURAGIN

ENCOURAGING SOFT MOBILITY: ON THE MOVE!

Set against the mountains, Vaujany is developed in tiers. Housing, shops and infrastructure are located at different levels. With the aim of making it easier for residents and holidaymakers alike to get around, Vaujany has always promoted soft transport within the resort: escalators and elevators provide effortless links between the various sites. Free shuttle buses run through the village in winter, linking Vaujany to Bourg d'Oisans. Finally, there are several free covered parking lots, so you can forget about your car for the duration of your stay. Electric recharging points are also available.

SPL Oz-Vaujany was the first to introduce the widespread use of GTL (Gas-To-Liquids) for its snow groomers. This innovative fuel, produced from gas, contains no impurities. It offers a much cleaner alternative to conventional diesel. What's more, it's odorless and rapidly biodegradable. The extra cost of using this fuel represents a significant budget, but it is a priority investment. The snow groomer drivers are all trained in eco-driving: thanks to a GPS system installed on the snow groomers, the drivers know exactly where they need to work on the ski area according to snow depths, limiting the number of machine « passes », and limiting the energy consumption.

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THE SKI LIFTS GET INVOLVED

► Adapting lift speeds

At Vaujany, the speed of the ski lifts is adapted to the number of skiers, in order to control energy consumption.

▶ Optimizing the fleet of snow guns

Older snow guns are gradually being replaced by the latest generation. They reduce air consumption, and therefore energy consumption, by more than a factor of 10. They also produce better-quality snow, with the result of fewer hours of grooming needed for much improved skiing.



WORK PLANNED WITH THE ENVIRONMENT IN MIND

Before starting any work on the ski area, environmental risks are identified, in particular thos concerning fauna, flora and wetlands. After completing work on the slopes, the teams replac the topsoil previously stockpiled, then sow the areas with endemic seeds. To protect birds, visuadisplays indicate potentially dangerous cables..

ESF, INCLUSIVE!

The Vaujany ESF has made handiskiing one of its core training and development areas. Equipped with 2 dual skis, a uniski, a kartski, a GMS (ski chair similar to a dualski) and a tandem ski. With 6 chairs adaptable to all types of disability, the ESF has trained 8 instructors in the use of this equipment, and other instructors will follow their example. The aim is to make Vaujany an inclusive resort in terms of sporting activities for people with disabilities, and to give them access to the pleasures of skiing and snowboarding. Family outings are organized, as well as autonomy training courses to teach disabled people how to drive these machines. Equipment available for loan during lessons.

THE SKATING RINK, A LEISURE AND SPORTS VENUE

With its 1 600m² of ice and spectator areas for up to 900 people, the Vaujany skating rink is as much a place dedicated to leisure activities for holiday visitors, as it is a venue for major sporting events or a place of local life with the many ice skating, field hockey and curling teams who have made it their training spot. For holiday visitors, the ice rink is a great place to relax, with events such as disco banquises bringing together all generations. It's also where local sports teams such as the « Amodio Figure Skating Academy », « Les Pierres de Feu » curling team, « Les Grizzlys de Vaujany » field hockey team and the « Vaujany Artistique Club » ice skating team. Finally, for those who prefer to contemplate rather than practice, the rink is also a Mecca for entertainment: there are regular professional field hockey and curling matches, as well as the annual International Skating Gala.

PORTRAIT - FLORENT AMODIO, A LIFE ON ICE

In Vaujany, it's impossible to talk about the skating rink without mentioning Florent Amodio. A former professional skater, he is now coach and founder of the Amodio Figure Skating Academy, founded in Vaujany in 2018. An exceptional skater, during his career he was crowned French elite champion, European champion and represented France at the Winter Olympics in 2010.

Florent discovered the village of Vaujany during his training for the Olympic Games and his summer internships. When the idea of creating an academy popped into his head, he instinctively thought of Vaujany: a place where athletes can fully dedicate themselves to the sport, an ncredible living environment, and infrastructures such as the swimming pool, spa or gymnasium, perfect for offering quality sports programs to athletes. The aim of the academy is to build a prestigious school, transmit the values of sport, and turn students into rigorous athletes, all in a spirit of sharing and mutual support. Beyond sport, Florent Amodio is also keen to ensure that these students continue their education, so as to prepare them for their entry into the world of work. An academy where every detail counts, and where tomorrow's greatest skaters are trained.



THE CONFIDENTIAL RESORT

WITH ALL THE BELLS AND WHISTLES

The location of Vaujany is exceptional. The resort lies at the foot of the Grandes Rousses massif, with a direct gondola link to Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine, one of the finest ski areas in the Northern Alps. Climbing to an altitude of almost 3 330 m, it offers 116 slopes for a total of 250 km of leisure skiing. There are four mythical itineraries with a total vertical drop of over 2 200 m, one of which ends with the demanding La Fare piste at the foot of Vaujany. The resort is one of the world's great skiing destinations, where glaciers, spruce undergrowth, powdery slopes and endless peaks will delight lovers of skiing and nature!

PISTE DE LA FARE: AN XXL DESCENT NEVER BEFORE SEEN IN THE ALPS

With its 800 m of vertical drop, varied terrain and technical sections, this black run is one to check off your « wishlist of ski runs » in your life! Starting from the Alpette, with its plunging view over the village of Vaujany, it winds its way between fir trees and steep rock faces, giving an impression of vertiginous skiing. An even sportier variant is available for the most muscular of thighs: 10 km downhill and 2 210 m of ascent! Departing from the Pic Blanc at 3 330 m, you join the tunnel run, then the Rousses run and finally reach La Fare as far as the Enversin.

MONTFRAIS SNOWPARK: LEARN TO RIDE LIKE A PRO!

In this playful space and in the heart of fir trees, apprentice freestylers can take advantage of an initiation organized by the Tourism Office. Under the tutelage of an expert instructor, everyone can learn to attempt tricks and tame the modules and jumps shaped by Quentin, an instructor and trainer of the local ski club's freestyle section. The days will pass in a friendly atmosphere. Riders will discover how a snowpark works and the rules for taking part in a mini-contest between the best riders, with prize-giving and good music.

FREERANDO SAFETY: FREEDOM AT YOUR FINGERTIPS!

- To satisfy your need for wide-open spaces and wilderness skiing, ESF Vaujany offers supervised freerando outings, a mix of alpine skiing and ski touring on several routes, depending on the level of participants and snow & weather conditions. Two options are available: a trip after taking the gondola to achieve a higher altitude, or a trip from the resort, directly on seal skins. With freerando, the aim is to experience a beautiful descent away from the slopes. The Vaujany off-piste area is one of the most beautiful in the Oisans region, and skiers can quickly find themselves far from the marked runs, in complete safety, with routes specifically designed for this mountain activity:
- <u>An introductory course</u>: the Montfrais Évasion a ½-day outing from Montfrais to l'Alpette, with a return on piste or off-piste, and the advantage of a small ascension in altitude for first timers in skins and a red piste-level descent.
- <u>An intermediate route</u>: the Tour des Cavalles, which can be done as a ½-day or full-day tour. This route takes in the Cavalles plain at 2800m alt, with a small positive vertical drop and the possibility of returning off-piste or onpiste, depending on ski level and fatigue.
- <u>An expert route</u>: for fans of beautiful slopes and wide-open spaces, this Grandes Rousses Évasion outing leaves nothing to be desired, offering a day's skiing in the Grandes Rousses ski area, with 300 m to 500 m of positive vertical drop. Black run level.
- « Vaujany l'Echappée » : 1 day up to 800 m ascent or more. Itinerary: Col du Sabot, Rissiou, Aiguillettes de Vaujany...

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SNOWSHOEING AT SUNSET!




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INTRODUCTION TO CURLING AND EISSTOCK
